- II. Welcome: Lucia Perales introduced herself and welcomed attendees and participants, giving the floor to Sandy Schaffer, who presented the rest of the Accountability and Special Programs team.
- III. Approval of minute: Maria Elvira Aguilar, asked to take some minutes to review the minute from May 2016. The first approval motion was called by Maria Elena Ortega, seconded by Virginia Gordián. Alejandra Martínez pointed out an error on Sofía Rocha's name, listed at the minute as Maria Rocha. The minutes were approved with that change.
- IV. *Icebraker:* Ma. Elvira Aguilar invited the attendance to participate in an activity to meet and greet the members of the group.
- V. Orange Unified State Preschool Programs. Shannon Brown, Cheryl Sosa y Marcela Galicia, provided information about the Afterschool Program, with presence at some District schools, which offers activities for kids ages 3 and 4 such as literacy, mathematics, STEM, art, music and theater in accordance with their age. The admission requirements were mentioned. They also talked about the Learning Links Program, designed for kids ages 0-4.
- VI. DELAC Bylaws review. María Elvira Aguilar explained the importance of DELAC Bylaws, giving the floor to Lucia Perales, who led an activity in which the participants determined and shared the meaning of DELAC in a personal way, such as communication, information, support, involvement, respect, fraternity, teamwork, results.
- VII. English Learner Services: Amber Tatch talked about the Annual Parent Notification Letter, Federal Title III and State Requirements, which first purpose is report the English Learner level in accordance with the most recent results of CELDT, CAASP or SBAC, taken last Spring. The second purpose is to notify the three existing options of Programs (SEI, ELM y ALT). Sonia Posthuma asked if the use of CELDT exam will continue, taking into consideration the Common Core Standards compliance, to which Amber Tatch replied this is the last year the CELDT will be applied, and the placement of a new test, ELPAC, will begin on Spring 2018 (school year 2017-2018). More information will be provided later on. Martha Rivas translated the Q&A.

VIII. DELAC official elections – Vice President and Secretary 2016-17. Elvira Aguilar asked the nominees to introduce themselves and state their service proposal to the attendance who listened and later voted. Patricia Chávez collected and counted the ballots. As previously defined, the positions were granted depending on the amount of votes. Patricia Vazquez was elected Vice President by 25 and Norma Leal as Secretary with 21.
